Morbern's **Defense Finish** is a revolutionary protective topcoat developed for the most demanding vinyl upholstery applications. Specifying **Defense Finish** on Morbern's seating grade vinyl is the ultimate protective layer against:

- Stubborn stains
- Abrasive scuffs and scrapes
- Everyday dirt and grime
  
- Premature aging

It doesn't stop there. **Defense Finish** maximizes:

- Ease of daily cleaning. Just wipe with a damp cloth.
- Abrasion resistance 6x over conventional vinyl top-coats
- New vinyl appearance and fabric life. Reducing maintenance and repeat upholstery costs.
- Usage of environment-friendly materials

**Defense Finish** has a decade of consistent performance in the transportation, marine and contract furnishings industry. Repeated laboratory testing showed no significant wear after 200,000 double rubs with #8 cotton duck using the Wyzenbeek test method.

## Vinyl & Defense Finish Cleaning Procedure

### Step 1: Daily Soiling

Removing everyday dirt and grime with a mild soap and fresh water solution. Rinse and wipe dry.

Minimum cleaning: Once weekly.

### Step 2: Stubborn Stains

(Crayon – eye shadow – chocolate – blood)

Wipe using soft cloth or soft brush. Use recommended detergent cleaners: Formula 409 or Fantastik.

Rinse with clean water and wipe dry.

### Step 3: Difficult Stains

(Ballpoint pen – lipstick – mustard – tar/asphalt)

Carefully clean the stained areas with lighter fluid or rubbing alcohol. Rinse with clean water and wipe dry.

CAUTION: Although vinyls protected with Defense Finish are resistant to most common stains, some fabric dyes can create permanent stains. To minimize these stains, it is recommended that immediate attention be given while following stated cleaning instructions. Solvents are highly flammable, keep clear of any sources of ignition. Wear protective gloves and ensure cleaning takes place in a well ventilated area. When using solvents, be careful cleaning around buttons, stitching and wooden or decorative trim. Solvents can seriously damage such items.
